Saturday 1 March – Sunday 7 December 2014**

A Heritage Lottery funded temporary exhibition and new accessible digital archive to commemorate the start of the First World War.

Exploring Bexhill’s contribution to the Great War, and discovering what life was like for soldiers, nurses, refugees and civilians in the resort, during the war.

The exhibition includes hands-on resources for families, children’s interpretation, film and the stories of individuals from Bexhill, and features costume, social history & military artefacts as well as local history and oral history.

A diverse programme of events will accompany the exhibition throughout the year including guided walks, lectures and children’s activities and workshops.
